

## ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT

The direct activities of Mark Bowden Design do not involve any manufacturing processes that cause harm to the environment, We do, however, seek to act responsibly in both our day to day office based work, and also in the implementation of our design projects. We endeavour to use resources and materials in a way that minimises our impact on the environment.

Our approach is as follows:

- All paper and bottles are recycled using the local authority recycling service.
- Laser and inkjet cartridges are recycled through manufacturers return scheme.
- Cleaning products and other consumables are purchased for their environmental merit wherever possible.
- All printing within the office, when required, is on recycled paper whenever possible.
- E-mail communications and drawing data are not printed out unless absolutely necessary. All such data is stored electronically.
- Wherever possible all design data and drawing material is issued electronically to clients, local authorities and contractors.
- Where possible, materials specified for a scheme will be lowest impact environmental impact possible e.g. timber from sustainably managed forests, water based paints and lacquers, low energy light sources etc.
- Travel to sites and meetings will be via public transport where possible. All required car journeys will be undertaken in low carbon emission vehicles producing less than 120g/km.

Mark Bowden Design will continually monitor its practices and policy with regard to the environment. All staff and associates will be kept informed of any development of this policy.
